Introduction

- Triangle Orthopaedic Associates, P.A. employs approximately 324 people. Our Chapel Hill location has 12 employees.
- Employees work at multiple sites: 2 sites in Durham County, 1 site in Orange County, 1 site in Person County, 3 sites in Granville County, 1 site in Chatham County and 5 sites in Wake County.
- The majorities of employees work from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., but TOA has continued to implement flexible schedules when allowable.

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Section Two – How Information is Disseminated to Employees

The Triangle Orthopaedic Associates Transportation Management Plan focuses on three primary commuting modes: carpool, public transit, and flex-time scheduling. To support the use of these commuting modes, Triangle Orthopaedic Associates disseminates information about alternative modes of transportation to its employees by the following methods:

- Transportation Coordinator is the point of contact for employees on commuting alternatives.
- Company-wide Emails – TOA periodically does a mass email to alert employees about ozone action days, special transit-related events and remind them of the trip reduction goals the company has set.
- Information Posted on TOA Website
- New Hire Orientation.

Section Three – Current and Planned Travel Reduction Measures

To encourage employees to use alternative modes of transportation – carpool, public transit, cycling – or to work hours which do not necessitate driving during peak commute hours, Triangle Orthopaedic Associates has instituted the programs listed below. We intend to continue these programs in the year ahead and expand on them as demand increases.

- Limited flex-time scheduling

Programs planned for the upcoming year include:

- Ability for employees to work from home more frequently when possible.
- Schedule employees to work at locations closer to home when schedule allows.

Section Four – Travel Reduction Goals

Triangle Orthopaedic Associates collected baseline information through an online survey to all of our employees. As of October 2008, 6.1% of all employees who responded are using a method other than a single occupancy vehicle to travel to and from the workplace. We recently sent the GO Chapel Hill Survey to all Chapel Hill staff and will reflect these findings in the near future.

Summary:

The most common reasons for not participating in public transportation or car/van pools are: need vehicle for personal errands/family responsibilities; no one to carpool with, irregular work schedule, and need vehicle in case of emergency.

TOA would like to increase the current level of participation by its population, to further decrease peak commute trips over the coming year through use of either alternative modes or non-peak commute trips. We allow work from home when possible, and allow employees to work at locations closer to home when schedule allows.
